Dear BCIT Parents/Guardians,

As we anticipate the start of the new school year and in an effort to provide ongoing continuity for our students regarding meals, we have been in contact with our food service company, Sodexo and have outlined some changes listed below. Food pickups and deliveries will remain the same through Thursday, September 3, 2020.

We will not have food service on Monday, September 7, 2020 because of the Labor Day holiday, but we will instead have food service pickups and deliveries on Tuesday, September 8 and Thursday, September 10, 2020. Please note that the hours for pickup will now be between 9:00 a.m. - 10:00 a.m. The pickup days will then continue throughout the school year on Mondays and Thursdays from 9:00 a.m. - 10:00 a.m. commencing on Monday, September 14, 2020.

For students whose schedule is 100% remote, alternative arrangements are being made for those parents/guardians to pick up their child's meals at the respective campuses where the student attends. A follow-up communication from the building administration will be sent prior to the start of the school year to confirm locations.

We encourage you to visit our district website on a regular basis to monitor potential changes in schedules as it pertains to the school calendar. If you have any questions, please contact your building administration.

I want to thank our food service staff, administration and transportation personnel for their ongoing efforts to assure that our eligible students and families are served.
