Dear Parents,

Within the past few weeks, our Board and district administration have created a Reopening of School Task Force to address three essential focus areas: 1) What needs to be done to reopen schools in September; 2) What is the plan after reopening of school and a staff member or student comes down with Covid-19, and 3) What if schools were not able to open in person in September. Over the next few weeks, plans will be put into place for each of the scenarios. It is our plan to reopen schools in September with a very scripted plan of processes and procedures. These are complex issues to address as we look to assure a safe school environment for all parties involved and re-engage students physically to their respective schools while maintaining social distancing protocols.

To this end, our New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE), our Board and administration thank you for your heroic efforts to support your children's schools and the learning process during closings due to the coronavirus pandemic.
