Public Comments - Superintendent Agenda Only:

Cynthia Adams, BCITEA President: Questioned why Central Administration salaries were not identified and posted. Questioned why Interim Asst. Supt. Is being renewed in violation of the State Law 2011 Principal Residence. Questioned non-aligned shared salaries. Questioned the Non-renewing the lowest paid employees, Teacher Aides, yet some non-aligned on report are receiving 20.2% increase. Some Teacher Aides are retiring will you be bringing back those that you non-renewed upon their retirement?

William Burns, Bd Solicitor: Central Administration is in the midst of negotiations and will be posted when approved. Can not discuss personnel issues in public without having been RICED.

Cynthia Adams: Item I.B.1., How can we be abolishing Speech Language Therapist Program when high percent of students are in need of this?

Dr. Chris Nagy: IEP Speech requirements will be met, there is a substantial savings to support operations this is an economy of scale situation.

Dr. Chris Nagy: We have received a few retirements of Teacher Assistants and are looking to bring back staff that are needed by the end of June.

Dorothy Hoffman, parent: Parent's need better communication, school notifies for special functions, but BoE information that concerns district operations is not given. Requested that we use two microphones for BoE meetings. Concern that we only gave Vocal Instructor 2 years when usually a new program is given 4. What educational background does this Board of Education members have and how long is your appointed term?

Kerry Nevadomski, parent: Concerned and would like to know scheduled plan and information regarding Childcare program as has one child that attended and one currently attending.

Dr. Chris Nagy: Understands her concerns and are in the process of analyzing the program and the parents will be notified when a decision is made.

Nicola Hampton: Request that Supt.'s agenda be made available before the night of the meeting. No answers from the Board for questions being asked appears no diligence. Need a process for responding to concerns. Request an overview of all committee meetings on website.

Robert Silcox: There are legal processes, such as RICE notices, but will look into providing agenda and utilizing website for information.

Courtney Amen, BCITEA Vice President: RICE notices were given to everyone before this meeting. When can answers be given in public session.

William Burns: Personnel Issues can not be discussed in public, but general salaries can be given after action taken.

Cynthia Adams, BCITEA President: Requested all Aides/Parafessionals that were attending meeting to please stand-up. These members of our school community makes the least salary. TA's are paid through IDEA grant. If this is a way for our school to go to privatization which is not in the best interest of students.

Emily Hoffman, Student BCIT-Medford: Current student in Vocal Program. How can one teacher do both vocal and instrumental? Concerned that school didn't give program 4 years to become established. Wasn't enough time for what we need.

Dr. Chris Nagy: We are working with Principals and information will be distributed next week to families in this program.

1. Renewal of Food Services Contract Addendum, District, 2017-2018 School Year

A one year contractual agreement effective July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018 with the option to renew for two (2) additional years, with Sodexo Management, Inc. (FSMC) based on the following terms:

Burlington County Special Services School District

a. Administrative Fee:

General Support Services Allowance equal to One Hundred Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety Seven Dollars (\$108,797) for the 2017-2018 contract year, payable in ten equal installments of Ten Thousand Seven Hundred and Nineteen Dollars and Seventy Cents (\$10,879.70), September through June, computed at the end of each Accounting Period and prorated for any partial Accounting Period. Partial Accounting Period shall be defined as a period of time less than one (1) month.

b. Guarantee:

District and Sodexo shall work together to ensure a financially sound operation and shall guarantee financial results for the 2017-2018 school year as follows:

Deficit Guarantee:

If Food Service operations result in a Deficit greater than Five Hundred Ninety Two Thousand Six Hundred Twelve Dollars (\$592,612) for the 2017-2018 school year, the following shall apply: Sodexo shall reimburse District for the Deficit greater than Five Hundred Ninety Two Thousand Six Hundred Twelve Dollars (\$592,612) in an amount not to exceed one hundred percent (100%) of Sodexo's annual General Support Services Allowance.

Burlington County Institute of Technology

a. Administrative Fee:

General Support Services Allowance equal to Thirty Two Thousand One Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$32,130) for the 2017-2018 contract year, payable in ten equal installments of Three Thousand Two Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$3,213), September through June, computed at the end of each Accounting Period and prorated for any partial Accounting Period. Partial Accounting Period shall be defined as a period of time less than one (1) month.

b. Management Fee:

District shall pay Sodexo a Management Fee in an amount equal to Fifty Six Thousand Six Hundred Ten Dollars (\$56,610) payable in ten equal installments of Five Thousand Six Hundred Sixty One Dollars (\$5,661), September through June for the 2017-2018 contract year. The Management Fee shall be calculated at the end of each Accounting Period during the school year and prorated for any partial Accounting Period. Partial Accounting Period shall be defined as a period of time less than one (1) month.

c. Guarantee:

District and Sodexo shall work together to ensure a financially sound operation and anticipate to breakeven for the 2017-2018 school year.

2. Shared Vehicle Fleet Management Contract
