Public Comments:

C. Adams, BCITEA President: Readdressed several positions with excessive percentages of shared positions since 2013/14. Questioned what commanded the salary of a shared IT Secretary when a BCIT union secretary with the same credentials earns less after 29 years. There is still no contract after one year, requesting an average-fare increase, fair salary for educators who care about the students and do an excellent job. Shared staff positions may not be working.

D. Hoffman, Parent, BCIT: Disappointed in loss of Vocal program at Medford Campus. Appreciated all the staff that helped her daughter. Asked questions about holding accountable. Disappointed that the staff do not have a contract, that this is political and not about the children.

D. Montgomery, parent of Student in BCIT Early Childhood Ed: Teacher Aides are more than just Aides they are heroes inside and outside of class. Everything they do is beneficial. Please do not replace with just anyone, these children are our future.
