Field Technician duties include inspecting sites to ensure that people are not exposed to chemical or occupational hazards such as lead, asbestos, pesticides, or unsafe equipment. At clients' facilities, technicians perform sampling tests of different materials such as soil, air, and water to test for the presence of pollutants. Taking detailed notes and documenting monitoring practices are an essential part of the work.

- Daily tasks are assigned, directed, and supervised by senior project managers or senior technicians.
- Assignments are of varying complexity and under direction of a project manager and director.
- A strong work ethic, attention to detail, and punctuality is necessary.
- Reliable transportation to mobilization sites and regional travel is required.
- Willingness to be trained.
- Time management, independent thinking, self-motivation, and initiative are essential.
