## Half Day Camps

### “All About Me” Cosmetology Camp

(Westampton&Medford)

Campers will have the opportunity to gain hands on skills relating to the cosmetology field. During the week, campers will be able to consult with a perspective client, how to drape, shampoo, roller and perm set hair. Additionally they will learn how to create single and on the scalp braids (without extensions), as well as basic manicure and facial techniques.

### Computer-Aided Design (Westampton)

Campers will be introduced to Computer - Aided Design softwares including AutoCAD, Inventor, Solidworks and Revit Architectural software. Please note, this camp is recommended for those entering grade eight as of September 2019. **CAD01**

### Creative Writing Camp (Westampton)

Want to create worlds with your imagination? Explore your lyrical voice? Have a story only for YOU to tell? If so, come unlock the magic that is Creative Writing Summer Camp! **CRW01**

### Forensic Science Camp (Westampton)

This camp will provide campers with the opportunity to learn, practice, and analyze forensic science information. The campers will have a hands on experience using video tutorials, cooperative problem solving games and completing virtual and in-person analysis. Campers should expect to learn and apply different forensic science skills (i.e. finger print collection and analysis, DNA electrophoresis, chromatography, etc.) through a case study approach. The camp will culminate with the students investigating and analyzing crime scene evidence to solve a given case study example crime. **FOS01**

### Graphics & Animation Camp (Westampton)

Get creative through exciting experiences using 3D printing, digital cameras, state of the art computers and software to create cartoons, animation, manga art and designs. Campers will also be introduced to digital photography skills with hands-on demonstrations and lessons. In the classroom, discover Photoshop, Illustrator and other creative apps. **GRA01**

### Introduction to Drone Technology Camp (Westampton)

Campers will be introduced to the form and function of simple drones, the FAA107 test, flying techniques and other elements of drone technology. This camp will provide a hands-on flying experience as well as prep for the FAA license. **DRT01**

### Introduction to Robotics Camp (Westampton)

Campers will collaboratively build robots and compete in the VEX IQ Challenge: Bank Shot. Campers use VEX IQ robotics kits to build pre-designed robots, following a set of instructions. Once campers have learned the basics of construction and programming, through the use of videos and guided practice, campers are able to redesign and rebuild their robot. Campers will have the opportunity to participate in three challenges: Teamwork Challenge, Collaboration Challenge and Programming Skills Challenge. **ROB01**

### Introduction to Robotics Camp II (Westampton)

In Introduction to Robotics II, campers will once again collaboratively build robots and compete in more advanced versions of the VEX IQ Challenges from Introduction to Robotics I. Campers will use VEX IQ robotics kits to build autonomous robots to their own design. Once campers have created their first robot, they will have opportunity to modify, rebuild, and test their designs and programs. Campers may also attempt the Programming Skills Challenge on unmodified Bank Shot, in which a single robot completes the match autonomously. **ROB02**

### Introduction to the World of Welding (Medford)

Campers will be introduced to the world of welding, from the basic safety concerns and procedures to careers available. Campers will get hands on experience gaining the knowledge and basic skills using SMAW(Stick) and GMAW(Mig) equipment to create welds on sample material. This camp is recommended for campers entering grade eight as of September 2019. **WEL01**

### STEM\* Challenge Camp (Westampton)

Campers will explore various scientific principals related to chemistry, physics, engineering, and technology. In this camp, they will work cooperatively in order to build, examine, and test various objects through experimentation. Campers should expect to build a solar oven, fuel cell car, rockets, roller coasters, and much more. These projects promote problem solving, experimental design, cooperative learning, and self confidence. **STEM01**

### Veterinary Assistants Camp (Medford)

Veterinary Assistant Summer Camp will introduce campers to the essentials in veterinary assisting. This includes animal restraint, medication application, basic pharmacology, potential careers in veterinary medicine, and basic veterinary terminology. Hands on experience will include: applying a noose leash, using a noose leash as a muzzle, restraint for physical exam, applying eye drops, applying ear drops, and applying topical medication. Labs will include a bandaging lab, vital statistics lab (pulse, heart rate, capillary refill time), intravenous fluids, and a live fish exam/habitat evaluation. Please join us for an exciting introduction to the expanding world of veterinary medicine. **VET01**



## Culinary Camps

### Culinary Cuisines *(Westampton)*

Come learn how to prepare sweet and savory recipes that you and your family will enjoy! With our chef, campers explore the secrets of cooking and receive valuable insights into culinary arts. Activities include orientation to equipment use, how to make homemade salsa, food truck sandwiches and fun desserts. Campers will also explore ethnic and cultural dishes from around the world. By the end of the session, all will have their own recipe book to take home. **CUL01**

### Cup Cake Camp 1 *(Westampton)*

Calling all cupcake makers! Campers will create assorted cupcakes using given recipes and instructions. Campers will decorate, eat, and take home the cupcakes created! **CUP01**

### Cup Cake Camp 2 *(Westampton)*

Are you ready for more cupcakes? Campers work in groups to more advanced cupcakes. This camp serves as an extension of Cupcake Camp 1 and focuses on more advanced baking and icing skills. Campers should look forward to taking home the various cupcake creations! **CUP02**

### Junior Iron Chef Camp - Pastabilities *(Westampton)*

Campers will have the opportunity to discover the world of pasta and how it can be used in the culinary field, from basic pasta dishes to the more elegant types of gourmet pastas being used today. **JIC01**

### Camp Rock-n-Roll *(Westampton)*

Camp Rock n Roll will provide the campers with the opportunity to play and sing in a rock n roll band, performing and recording both cover songs and original compositions. **RR01**

### Create Your Own TV Show Camp *(Westampton)*

Campers will learn to produce their own TV show start to finish. Over the course of the one-week session, our campers will be part of a team that scripts, shoots, and edits an original TV show. Each day offers a new aspect of studio production. Campers will be exposed to cameras, lighting, chroma-key, graphics and original music creation. **TV01**
